

BCWA Officials of the Year Awards Policy

The BC Wrestling Association Officials of the Year will be awarded annually. Nomination process will be communicated to members via www.bcwrestling.com. Selection and presentation of award recipients will be determined by the BCWA Board of Directors and will be communicated to the members. The decision on the recipients of the Officials of the Year by the BCWA Board of Directors is considered final.

Eligibility (mandatory):

Must have been an active official for at least the previous 2 years.

An official may be an on-mat official and/or a pairing master.

Must be a current registered member of and in good standing with BCWA.

Must have participated in at least four competitions sanctioned by BCWA, BCSS, and/or WCL.

Must not have received at any time sanction for any malpractice or Code of Conduct violation.

Selection Criteria (recommended):

Participation in BCWA, BCSS, and WCL sanctioned events for the period from May 1st of the previous year to April 30th of the current year of the award.

Community support for individual and/or affiliated wrestling program.

Support and encourage athlete participating in the following:

- A. Participating in BCWA physical testing evaluation, meeting the established benchmarks once per year.
- B. Participating in planned, monitored, and evaluated off-mat strength & conditioning program.
- C. Attending BCWA provincial training camps.
- D. Attending BCWA Provincial Development practices.

Overall contribution to wrestling in BC.

Continuing to represent BC and/or BC programs.

Procedure:

- 1. BCWA calls for nominations. May of calendar year.
- 2. Nominations are submitted. Deadline June 30 of calendar year.
- 3. BCWA Technical Committee reviews and selects award recipients. August of calendar year.
- 4. BCWA announces award recipients. Presentation of Officials of the Year Awards will be determined by the BCWA Board of Directors and will be communicated to the members.

Categories:

Aspirant Official of the Year – Official with less than 5 years' experience.

Senior Official of the Year – Official with more than 5 years' experience.

Up to two award recipients may be selected for each category.
